## Apartment set-up for resettling refugees

Please collect every item on the Essentials list. The optional items are not necessary to collect, but will make the refugees feel more at home. You may collect more than the number of items listed. For instance, the list might say 1 box of lightbulbs. But if you would like to donate 3 boxes, we will gladly accept 3 boxes.

**Please only collect the items on this list.** Some things that might seem essential but are not on this list we have collected through other means, so please only collect the items on this list.

### Kitchen Essentials

- Rice cooker- 16 cup
- Dish sets with plates, glasses or cups, bowls, mugs
- Silverware set with butter knives, forks, and spoons
- 4 Baby spoons
- 2 Baby bottles
- 4 Dish towels
- Stock pot 16 qt. (may be lightly used)
- Saucepan (may be lightly used)
- Frying pan (may be lightly used)
- Baking dish set (may be lightly used)
- Mixing/serving bowls (may be lightly used)

### Kitchen Cleaning Essentials

- All-purpose kitchen cleaner
- 10 Wash rags
- 4 Paper towels
- 10 Sponges
- Liquid dish soap
- Mop
- Broom & dust pan
- Kitchen garbage can
- Kitchen garbage bags (1 roll of 100 or more)
